English

This term, we will be reading texts relating to our History topic on Vikings. These will include 'Odd and the Frost Giants' by Neil Gaimon and non-fiction texts about Vikings. The children will also be practising their grammar. They need to know and understand terminology including noun, proper noun, pronoun, verb, adverb, adjective, conjunction, preposition, determiner and fronted adverbial. For punctuation, they need to ensure they are using full stops, commas, exclamation marks, question marks, capital letters, inverted commas and apostrophes correctly.

Mathematics

The children have been doing well learning their times tables, but still need to make sure they practise, because by the end of Year 4, they must know all of them up to 12. Also in maths, we will be practising our skills finding fractions of amounts, using negative numbers, and solving reasoning problems involving all four operations.
