Learning logs

Every child from Year 1 to Year 6 has a learning log to use at home. A learning log is a book or folder that the children can work in at home. The teachers will set a task or a question, and the children will need to find out everything they can. The children can decide how they want to present it: in writing, in pictures, with charts and graphs, or even by making models. They can use their reading, writing and maths skills. We think the learning logs are a great opportunity for you to work with your children and talk to them about their interests.

Home learning bags

I am very pleased to tell you that we give “home learning bags” to every child from Reception to Year 6. Home learning bags contain pencils, crayons, felt tips, scissors, rulers, rubbers and glue sticks – everything your children need to work in their learning logs at home.
