English

This term, we are reading a range of texts including an abridged version of the Anglo-Saxon epic poem, 'Beowulf'. We are also reading the gothic poem 'The Raven' by Edgar Allan Poe. We will be writing description, narratives and poetry. You can help your child by reading with them every day and encouraging them to spend time reading independently. The children borrow books from a lending library at school and are developing awareness of their favourite authors. We recommend going to Rochdale library and allowing the children to look for other books by these authors.

Mathematics

The children have been doing well learning their times tables, but still need to make sure they practise, because by the end of Year 4, they must know all of them up to 12. Also in maths, we will be practising formal methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions and decimals and telling the time. You can help your child practise telling the time at home.

Science

Our Science question is 'What are solids, liquids and gases?" See the knowledge organiser for more information.
