

Year Three Geography knowledge organiser– Where on the Earth are we?

Key vocabulary:

Longitude-The distance on the earth's surface east or west of an imaginary line on the globe that goes from the north pole

Latitude– The distance between the equator and point north or south on the earth's surface. This distance is measured in degrees.

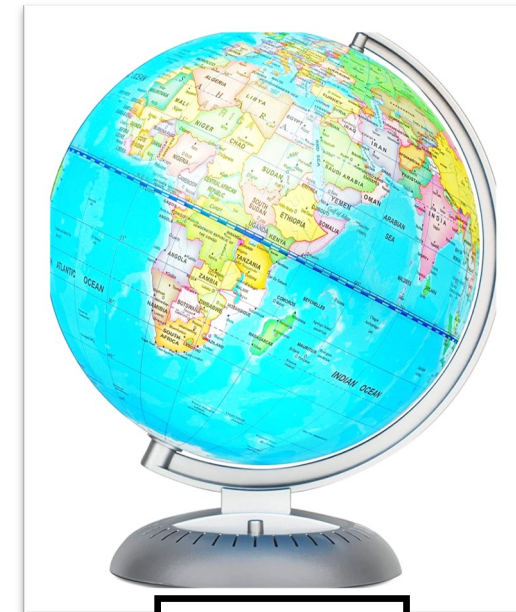
Equator-The imaginary circle around the earth that is halfway between the North and South Poles

Southern hemisphere– The half of the earth that is south of the equator.

Northern hemisphere-The half of the earth that is north of the equator.

Time zone-A region in which all the clocks are set to the same time. The earth is divided into twenty-four time zones. The time in each zone is one hour earlier than it is in the zone to its east.
