English

In English this half term our topic is journeys. We will continue using punctuation in our sentences. It is important the children are able to form their letters correctly and write a complete sentence and then check that this makes sense. We will be using a wide range of vocabulary in our work.

Mathematics

We will learn about measurement including length, height, time and money. They will continue tom learn by heart times tables facts and some division facts.

Science

This term the children will be looking at materials in more depth. We will be investigating everyday materials and their properties. The children will have the opportunity to think more about the properties of different materials and carry out investigations.

Religious Education

In R.E, the children this term will be learning about what it means to belong to a faith community with a special focus on Islam.

They will think about symbols and ceremonies used in Islam.
