We will be reading different stories and poems. We will continue using punctuation in our sentences. It is important the children are able to form their letters correctly and write a complete sentence and then check that this makes sense. We will be using a wide range of vocabulary in our work.



Mathematics

In maths the children will be doing lots of work with number and measures. They will begin to use their knowledge addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to solve word problems. We will learn about measurement including length, height, time and money. They will continue to learn by heart times tables facts and some division facts.



Science

This term the children will be learning about the changes from spring to summer and the basic structure of plants. They will grow plants and watch their growth over time and make observations.



Religious Education

In R.E, the children this term will be learning about what the Five Pillars of Islam and what it means to be a Muslim.

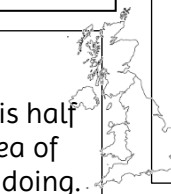
Dear Parents ,and Carers,

Here is your curriculum newsletter for this half term. This newsletter will give you an idea of all of the different things that we will be doing.

A few reminders:

- Please ensure children bring their reading books to school every day.
- Please read with your child daily as this helps them with practising blending and segmenting for reading.
- Children will be getting spellings every week. Please help your child to learn these as we will be having a test every Thursday and this will support them in developing their writing.
- P.E. will remain on a Tuesday this half term. Please make sure your child has a full P.E. kit that includes pumps.
- In maths it is important that the children continue to learn basic number skills. If you could continue to practise counting forwards, backwards to 100, number bonds to 20 and the 2, 5 and 10 times table, this will really help your child to progress.
- The knowledge organisers sent home with this letter are to allow the children to learn facts at home alongside what they learn in school. These can be referred back to throughout the half term.

Geography
