Dear parents/guardians,


We are now entering the last term for your child at Ashfield Valley Primary School!

#### History

This term in history we will be learning about education from 1066 to the present day. We will be making comparisons about what school was like, who was allowed to go to school and the subjects that were taught there.

#### Science

In science, we will be completing our topic about microorganisms and living things as well as learning about the work of scientist Alexander Fleming.
