Visits during term time

This is my regular reminder that visits abroad or holidays during term time will not be authorised and we will use all measures available to us such as fines and pupils losing their school place to discourage this.

We are aiming for 96% attendance and the minimum government expectation is 95%.

Attendance the week before half term was 94.8% - below minimum expectation.

147 sessions have been lost to unauthorised visits and holidays and 14 pupils have missed learning because of this.
