English

This term, we are reading a range of texts including The Wolves in the Walls by Neil Gaimon, a poem called 'Overheard on a Salt Marsh' by Harold Monro and The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. We are going to read both fiction and non-fiction texts and write character descriptions. newspaper articles, poems and nonchronological reports. We will also be learning how to answer different types of questions. You can help your child by reading with them every day and encouraging them to spend time reading independently.

Mathematics

We will be focussing on place value of up to 4-digit numbers and will be practising the column addition and subtraction methods, as well as formal methods for multiplication and division. There will be a big focus on learning all the times tables this year. You can help your child by practising times tables whenever possible. If you have five minutes to kill, do times tables! This will help enormously with all other areas of maths. Children are expected to know all times tables up to 12 by the end of Year 4.

Science
